

The York County Board of Commissioners, ex-officio the York County Board of Equalization, met April 20, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. as per notice in the York News Times on April 15, 2010, with Augustus M. There were no Tax List Corrections to be brought before the Board.

A Real Estate Tax Exemption for Region V Foundation was reviewed. The property is located on Lots 9 & 10 Blk 33 Original Town, City of York. This property is to be used as a consignment store/training worksite for people with developmental disabilities.

Moved by Bergen, seconded by Neujahr to approve the tax exempt application for Region V and also to waive the late fee; roll call: yeas, Bergen, Neujahr, Bulgrin, Bredenkamp and Brown; nays, none; motion carried.
