

The York County Board of Commissioners, ex-officio the York County Board of Equalization, met March 22, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. as per notice in the York News Times on March 16, 2011, with Chairman, Kurt Bulgrin presiding with Pat Bredenkamp, Bill Bamesberger, Paul Buller and Tom Shellington. Also present at the meeting was Melanie Wilkinson, correspondent for the York News Times.

The Board began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The agenda of the meeting was posted on the bulletin board in the County Clerk's office and a copy of the agenda was made available to each Commissioner.

Ann Charlton, County Assessor, presented the Real Estate Tax Exemption application for Wessels Living History Farm on 16.85 acres which was amended from 13.66 acres.

Moved by Bredenkamp, seconded by Bamesberger to approve the Real Estate Tax Exemption for Wessels Living History Farm for the NE ¼ of 25-10-3, 16.85 acres in total; roll call: yeas, Bredenkamp, Bamesberger, Buller, Shellington and Bulgrin; nays, none; motion carried.

A request for Motor Vehicle Tax Exemption for Nebraska Evangelical Lutheran High School was discussed.

Moved by Bredenkamp, seconded by Shellington to approve the Motor Vehicle Tax Exemption application for Nebraska Evangelical Lutheran High School on a 2006 Econoline Wagon VIN #1FBNE31L1DA03898; roll call: yeas, Bredenkamp, Shellington, Buller, Bamesberger and Bulgrin; nays, none; motion carried.
