

The York County Board of Commissioners, ex-officio the York County Board of Equalization, met April 5, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. as per notice in the York News Times on March 31, 2011, with Chairman, Kurt Bulgrin presiding with Pat Bredenkamp, Bill Bamesberger, Paul Buller and Tom Shellington. Also present at the meeting were Ann Charlton, County Assessor and Melanie Wilkinson, correspondent for the York News Times.

The Board began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The agenda of the meeting was posted on the bulletin board in the County Clerk's office and a copy of the agenda was made available to each Commissioner.

Bulgrin announced that the open meetings law would be in effect and that a copy was posted outside the door and available on the table in the back of the room. Proof of publication was also available.

Moved by Shellington, seconded by Bredenkamp to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2011 Board of Equalization meeting as presented; roll call: yeas, Shellington, Bredenkamp, Buller, Bamesberger and Bulgrin; nays, none; motion carried.

Moved by Bamesberger, seconded by Shellington to adopt the agenda for the Board of Equalization; roll call: yeas, Bamesberger, Shellington, Bredenkamp, Buller, and Bulgrin; nays, none; motion carried.

Ann Charlton, County Assessor, presented the Real Estate Tax Exemption application from First United Methodist Church of York Foundation. They are asking for an exemption for Lt 1 Blk 39 OT City of York (727 North Burlington Ave.) and any personal property on premises. Randy Cordes Chairman of the Trustees came before the Board.

This property will be used as a garden for church members. Many vegetables raised are donated. No fees are involved. The garage on the property is used for storage.

Moved by Shellington, seconded by Buller to approve the application for Lt 1 Blk 39 OT City of York; roll call: yeas, Shellington, Buller, Bredenkamp, Bamesberger and Bulgrin; nays, none; motion carried.
